- Prepare and package ~140 holiday meals at Victory Mission's Warehouse for distribution through deliveries and mobile food pantries

across Springfield.

- Occasionally work alongside men and women in our Restoration program.
- Have an attitude of love and compassion.
- Minimize interruptions by keeping cell phones and other distractions out of sight

Skills:

- Ability to withstand semi-outdoor cold temperatures in our warehouse complex.
- Ability to stand for 3 hours
- Ability to lift 20lbs.
- Ability to be punctual, reliable, and work as a team.
