Job Description: Gardening

Impact: Victory Mission serves more than 200 meals daily to men and women in the [Restoration Program](#), [Emergency](#) and [Transitional Shelter](#). Help provide healthy locally-grown options for program participants by serving in Victory Mission's community garden.

Responsibilities / Expectations :

- Maintaining garden beds by planting, weeding, mulching and watering.
- Shovel mulch, dirt, and compost into raised garden beds.
- Harvest produce.
- Assist with the construction of new gardening beds if needed.
- Interact with program participants in a loving, kind, and understanding manner.
- Practice safety and established protocols of Victory Mission.
- Dress appropriately for the weather.
- Stay hydrated. Bring your own water bottle.

Skills:

- Ability to take simple directions for tasks on hand.
- Ability to stand, lift for two hours.
- Ability to maneuver watering hoses safely.
- Ability to lift 25-50 lbs.

- Shift begins at 8:00am and ends at 10:00am, on Saturdays (April - October), weather permitting.
