**Responsibilities / Expectations :**

- Provide personal, kind and respectful care to families in need.
- Fill orders for food assistance.
- Commit to serving a complete shift at your church and/or the Victory Mission Pantry Team.
- Interact with program participants in a loving, kind, and understanding manner.
- Minimize interruptions by keeping cell phones and other distractions to a minimum.
- Be punctual and reliable for the shifts. Call if you need to cancel.
- Adhere to Victory Mission's statement of faith.
- Practice safety and established protocols of Victory Mission.

**Skills:**

- Ability to engage with all kinds of people in a friendly, graceful and kind way.
- Ability to stand for 1.5 hours
- Ability to lift 20lbs.
- Be punctual and reliable.

**Setting:**

- Location: all pantry events are outdoors. We have shelter, but no indoor option, so please dress appropriately for the weather.

**Screening / Onboarding:**

- Because of the vulnerability of the population we serve at Victory Mission, all volunteers are required to submit to a background check, interview, and chaplain approval prior to serving.

- Once an application is received, and your background check is complete, you will be contacted about the status of your background check.
- If approved, you will be asked to schedule an interview with the Outreach Chaplain Team.
